<i>How have I incorporated the key competencies and values into the programme?</i>	
<i>Have I incorporated the ideas outlined in the Best Evidence Synthesis into my programme?</i>	
<i>How well am I catering for the needs of my Māori and Pasifika students in my programme?</i>	
<i>Which achievement standards have I chosen to assess in my programme? Am I using the new standards? Which assessment tasks am I using?</i>	<p>This has been deliberately placed at the end to encourage teachers to consider how to plan a programme which will be interesting and engaging for your students first and then choosing appropriate assessment to fit into the programme rather than using assessment to drive curriculum.</p>
